Alycat

Alycat 9.5 has been released and purchased by the club. This is a greatly improved version and will accurately manage racing points in line with BRCCC regulations. A special thanks to Ken Scalley at Alycat who worked very closely with the BRCCC to align the points system as well as to resolve some unrelated bugs and add some very useful features.

The club Code of Conduct will be updated to formally publish details around the BRCCC points system.

While the system has not changed, it has never been fully detailed to members.

Classes for 2016

The classes are unchanged from 2015. However, Formula 1 will return to 4 rounds of races. Note that for 2016, the following will apply:

- In order to qualify for trophies within a class (per season), drivers must complete 10 or more meetings.
- In order to qualify for club champion points, you must compete in a class that is consistently comprised of 3 or more members. This is to level the playing field by preventing a situation where one driver consistently receives 150 points each meeting due to being the only member within the class.

2016 Race Calendar

The 2016 race calendar has been published on our web site.

Season 1 qualifying is on January 20, 2016.

Round 1 is January 27, 2016

First committee meeting will be 7pm on Tuesday January 19 at the club rooms. All welcome.

2016 Track selection

Members have been looking at track options with a couple of ideas trialed. Two new layouts have been well received and will be used in 2016. The review of track layouts with members will continue. To open season 1, 2016 we will use the track layout from presentation night. This was very popular and hence has been adopted.

As with 2015, tracks will be published 1 week prior to end of month and each track will be used for one calendar month (there will be a degree of flexibility as new tracks are evaluated. Understand not all tracks will suit anti-clockwise and clockwise).

Christmas/New year Saturday Racing

Council have approved Saturday racing. So we intended to open the track for informal Saturday afternoon/twilight racing. Advance notice will be SMS-ed to members as well as updates on our web site home page. Expect a BBQ on these evenings for good measure.

2016 Drivers Stand – Construction begins

The BRCCC has been awarded a government grant to go towards the cost of building our new drivers stand. Sincere thanks go to Gary Logan who drove this project.

The BRCCC is very grateful for the planning assistance from Karl Withers and his company who will construct the new drivers stand which will also incorporate a new control room.

During the construction phase, the steps and 1st section of the old drivers stand will be demolished.

Rob Oberstar is providing temporary scaffolding (and steps) to allow access and racing from the old stand during the 8-week construction period. During the construction period the drivers stand will not be available to the public as security fencing will seal off the construction area.

As this newsletter goes to press, the BRCCC is working with Knox Council for the building permit. A planning permit is not required. We do not have any hurdles to jump, this is just a slow process as we are building on public land. The Council have and continue to be very supportive of this project. At this stage we anticipate construction to begin in March or April.
