won't be pressured to take on activities that are out of your comfort zone but we do want your ideas as well as any day to day assistance you can offer.


Alycat

Grid positions for Race 1 each week

Until recently the starting grid each week has been based on championship points to date. One limitation with this approach is that a new driver who is very competent may find themselves at the back of the grid for a number of weeks while catching up on points. This is more of an issue where a class is split into 2 groups.

Qualifying resolves this matter however the BRCCC race format is "points" and not "Finals" based.

Commencing with Round 6 we are trialing a new system. The final race results for the previous round will become the qualifying grid positions for the current week. Refer to the Alycat "Meet report" to see where you will grid for race 1 the following week. Club members grid ahead of non-members. Members who did not race the previous week have not qualified and therefore go to the back of the grid (but ahead of non-members).

Race Directing

Commencing with Round 6, a driver from each class will be selected to Race Direct. The selection excludes juniors and classes where there are less than 5 drivers.

Race directing involves complementing good driving behavior as well as pointing out errors (intentional or otherwise). It's not easy and not every situation will be detected however it will provide some continuity and help improve driving standards.

Race directors will be randomly selected and highlighted on the race list at the start of each meeting. The role will be rotated so it won't be the same people every week.

To our race directors for round 6 *Thank You*. You did a great job and the results are greatly appreciated.
