Hello everyone.

Welcome to this latest edition of the club Newsletter.

In this edition, we cover updates to Alycat and race entries, the Summer Series results, upcoming events and so much more.

During the Summer Series, we set up Alycat for On-Line registrations. The committee would like all members to trial this system and would appreciate feedback as to whether this is a useful service. Full details appear below.

We now have 2 new GoPro cameras to record all races every week. The combined cameras provide full coverage of our track. The purpose for these cameras are twofold:

- 1. Resolve racing incidents/protests
- 2. Training and driver education

A new splitter for PA speakers has been installed which will allow us to improve the quality of broadcast race information. Especially in the club room. The stereo speakers are also being replaced by weather proof PA speakers which provide clearer voice reproduction.

One speaker is now permanently installed on our drivers stand. Members practicing outside of club hours will now here their name and lap times called out (provided you have a transponder).

We will hold a working B shortly to complete works for the cameras, speakers and cabling and painting. Date to be advised shortly.

The Vic titles are being hosted at SERCCC's new track at Bittern on March 16-19. Entries close shortly so get cracking if you want to be a part of this great RC event.

I am relieved that our service has been fully restored with sincere thanks to our contact within Telstra.


On-Line Race Entries

During the Summer Series, we trialed the use of Alycat On-line entries. We have continued this option for our regular race meetings. The advantage of On-Line entries is that you can register to race during the week and not worry about being late to the track. Further, if you are going to arrive late, this ensures you will be registered. Thus, reserving your grid position for the 1st race. This part of Alycat also reduces the time and effort necessary to prepare a nights' racing.


How to enter on-line:

Go to <u>WWW.Alycat.com/oed</u> and select the "Boronia Season 1... meeting" then Enter Meeting.
