Club Transponders

The club transponders have not been serviced for 6-7 years and recently started to present some timing issues. We have now had a complete set of transponders refurbished and tested to address the problems.

Club transponders are rarely used these days with most regular racers purchasing personal transponders. However, the club transponders are essential for new drivers and those that don't have a personal transponder. On average the club only uses 3-5 club transponders on any night so it was decided to sell the 2nd set of transponders. Revenue from the sale covered the servicing costs with the balance going into our savings account. An additional benefit to this change is that drivers will be allocated a transponder for the night. No more returning after every race and grabbing the wrong colour for the next race. For non-members, we will hold car keys to ensure loan transponders are returned at the end of the night.

Summer Series 2017

The BRCCC will put on the summer series again in 2017 on Saturday evenings.

Commencing Saturday January 14 there will be 6 weekly rounds.

The format will comprise of 2 qualifying rounds, BBQ followed by 3 finals.
